

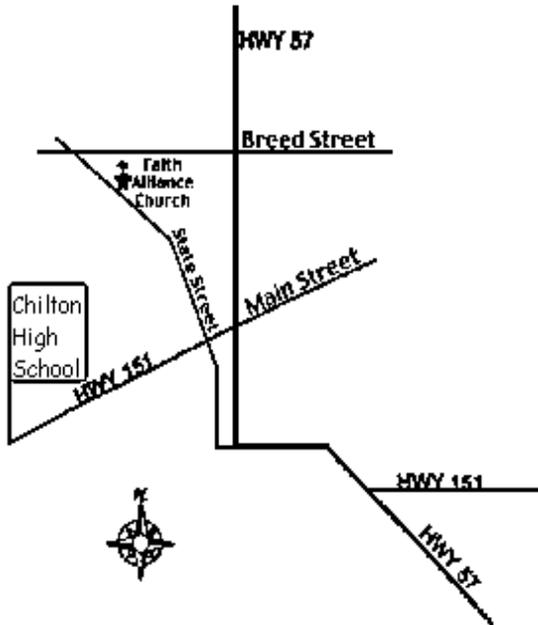
## Directions to Chilton High School

## “BROKEN OR BEAUTIFUL: INVITING GOD TO CREATE BEAUTY FROM OUR BROKEN PLACES”

Did you wake up this morning feeling beautiful? Or have circumstances in your life broken you down? Have you ever felt worthless? Doubted whether you have value? No matter who we are and where our journey through life has taken us, we all have beauty inside of us waiting to emerge from our broken places. If we are willing to trust God with the rubble of our lives, He can transform the pain from our past into something amazing that He can use for His plans and purposes.

Trish Propson had to dig through a lot of brokenness to find her beautiful. Growing up in a violent and abusive home, she survived a volatile childhood and teen years filled with anger, sexual abuse, violence, and exploitation. Surviving a drug overdose and suicide attempt in her early adult years, she finally surrendered her broken life to Christ as a young adult. Trish says, “Broken for the first time as a toddler, I am a survivor with a story that I hope helps women find their path to the beautiful within them. I am living proof that there is hope to reclaim the beautiful life God designed them for.”

*Trish is passionate about knowing God and using her journey to help others find healing and purpose for their lives. She shares her inner beauty as an author, newspaper columnist, licensed crisis response chaplain, counselor, and sexual abuse advocate.
