**SUPPORT OUR BENEVOLENT MINISTRY**-By purchasing scrip cards you can make the purchases you normally make and a percentage is paid to the Benevolent Fund -and it doesn't cost you anything.

Cards are available for hundreds of stores and can be purchased in amounts ranging from \$10-\$250. If you buy a Wal-Mart card you make your purchases, just like you normally would, and the scrip program pays 3% of everything you buy back to our Benevolent Fund. Plus you will get a receipt at the end of the year and can claim the 3% as a tax deduction. The system is the same for purchases made at Kohl's and Dairy Queen and Kwik-Trip and hundreds of other vendors. **If you give gift cards as Christmas gifts, consider purchasing them from our scrip program.** For more information, contact Char Nennig, our scrip coordinator.
