SUPPORT OUR BENEVOLENT MINISTRY-By purchasing scrip cards, which look like a credit card, you can make the purchases you normally make and a percentage is paid to the Benevolent Fund -and it doesn't cost you anything. Cards are available for hundreds of stores and can be purchased in amounts ranging from \$10-\$250. If you buy a Wal-Mart card you make your purchases, just like you normally would, and the scrip program pays 3% of everything you buy back to our Benevolent Fund. The system is the same for purchases made at Kohl's and Dairy Queen and Kwik-Trip, Seven Angels and hundreds of other vendors, though vendors do pay varying percentages to the charity.
