MISSIONS CONFERENCE-Our annual Missions Conference will be held October 14-18. Steve Williams will be our special guest. Steve and his wife Elizabeth are currently in the US for a one year home assignment but they will be serving in Senegal. Steve and Elizabeth have 2 teenage sons-Simon and Jude and are part of the Desert Springs Team in Senegal. Here is some information about Senegal and that team from the Alliance website.

Desert Springs Team

Senegal, a country of more than 13.6 million people, is one of The Alliance's newest fields. Evangelical Christians number about one-tenth of 1 percent of the population. An Alliance team entered the country in 2006.

Through partnering with an established evangelical church in northwest Senegal and workers with another mission, the team seeks to develop a church-planting movement in the region, primarily among the country's largest people group.

Alliance team members serve with this small group of Senegalese believers to accomplish the work to which God has called them, including administering a young women's training school, a health clinic, a Christian reading room, kid's clubs, and a vocational training school for young men.

In addition, the team ministers to nearly 300 street boys, who are among the thousands roaming Senegal's streets. Relinquished by parents who can't afford to feed them, these youngsters are given to local religious leaders, who require them to beg for their daily bread. Alliance workers seek to develop relationships with these boys and their teachers, providing medical check-ups, warm clothing, and hot meals to the youth.
