The Long March Home (F-BRO) A gripping tale of friendship, sacrifice and the power of unrelenting hope. Three young Alabama friends join the army in 1941 and end up in the Philippines – a place they call Eden! And

then Pearl Harbor is bombed and they become part of the "forgotten" as they end up prisoners of Japan.

Night Bird Calling (**F-GOH**) Appalachia, 1941. Lilliana flees her abusive husband to hid out in the country home of her great aunt in the foothills of N. Carolina. Abused by her husband, abandoned by her father and pursued by the Klan – but loved by a precocious 11 yr old, a young preacher and an elderly aunt!
